





Reserving Rooms

Study rooms can be reserved online from the library homepage within 24 hours of use. These are available to individuals and groups.

Meeting rooms can be reserved by faculty and staff more than 24 hours in advance using the college's EMS. Students can book a meeting room using the iPad next to the door.
